	2. Job vacancy.pdf Copy of the job advertisement you applied for showing the details of the job tasks.
	<b>3. Interview invitation.pdf</b> The employer's written invitation to the job interview including date, time, and place.
	4. Travel documents.pdf Copy of your travel documents or bookings connected to your travel to the job interview. In case of travel by car, keep all receipts of your journey (petrol, road toll etc) showing both the dates and the different locations of purchases. Copies of these receipts must be sent in after your travel for your application to be processed.
	<b>5. ID.pdf</b> Copy of passport or national identity card.
	6. Record.pdf CV and copy of qualifications/diploma.
